▶ **MODULE 03**

Why This Job Is Worth Looking At

Certification-based jobs are one of the fastest ways to jump into \$60K+ careers without a degree. Employers in IT, healthcare logistics, and transportation hire based on proof-of-skill, not diplomas. Many roles (like medical courier or NEMT driver) are in high demand, have low competition, and let you ramp up earnings quickly with the right paperwork.

What The Job Actually Does

Roles covered here include:

- Network Support Technician (with CCNA): Sets up and troubleshoots Cisco networks, often in enterprise or MSP environments.
- Medical Courier: Transports medical specimens, equipment, or prescriptions between labs, hospitals, and clinics.
- NEMT (Non-Emergency Medical Transportation) Driver: Drives patients to medical appointments, dialysis, or pharmacy runs, often for Medicaid/Medicare clients.

Each job involves a mix of technical skill, reliability, and compliance with specific regulations or certifications.

▶ MODULE 09

Beginner Roadmap

- 1 Pick your target job (Network Tech, Medical Courier, NEMT Driver).
- 2 Research local/state requirements for your role (Google: 'NEMT certification [your state]' or 'medical courier requirements [your city]').
- 3 Secure your basic requirements: driver's license, clean record, reliable vehicle (for driving roles).
- 4 For CCNA: Register for a Cisco-approved training or self-study (NetworkChuck Academy is a popular option).
- 5 For Medical Courier/NEMT: Apply for jobs on Indeed, CBDriver, CourierGigs, or directly

on company sites.

- 6 Ask the employer (or contract provider) what certifications/insurance are required—do not buy extra certs before you know exactly what's needed.
- 7 Complete any onboarding assessments or certifications provided after you're hired or contracted.

▶ **MODULE 10**

7-Day Action Plan

- 1 Day 1: Decide on your target role and research 3-5 local employers or contract providers.
- 2 Day 2: Gather your basic documents (license, vehicle info, resume).
- 3 Day 3: Search job boards (Indeed, CBDriver, CourierGigs, LinkedIn) using alternate job titles (see below).
- 4 Day 4: Apply to at least 5 jobs/contracts. Use the template script below for direct outreach.
- 5 Day 5: For IT roles, sign up for a free CCNA study resource or trial (e.g. NetworkChuck Academy).
- 6 Day 6: Follow up with employers you applied to—call or email to confirm receipt and ask about next steps.
- 7 Day 7: If offered a contract, ask the hiring manager to specify exact certification/insurance requirements before spending money.

▶ **MODULE 11**

30-Day Action Plan

- 1 Weeks 1-2: Complete any required training or certification (CCNA, NEMT, HIPAA, etc.).

- 2 Weeks 2-3: If required, purchase insurance only after confirming employer specs (commercial auto, general liability).
- 3 Week 3: Set up a business checking account if required for payment (see source: Bank of America, Wells Fargo, or local credit union).
- 4 Week 4: Complete onboarding assessments or background checks as required.
- 5 End of Month: Start your first shifts or routes; keep records of expenses and certifications for compliance.

▶ **MODULE 12**

Insider Secrets & Shortcuts

- 1 Don't buy certifications before you're hired—many medical courier/NEMT employers will tell you exactly which ones you need (and may pay for them). (Source: Medical Courier transcript)
- 2 For medical courier jobs, search using alternate keywords like 'specimen routes', 'stat routes', 'prescription delivery', and always try both 'driver' and 'contractor' on job boards like Indeed, CBDriver, CourierGigs, and Craigslist. (Source: Medical Courier transcript)
- 3 When applying for NEMT or courier roles, ask the company directly: 'What insurance and certifications do I need to onboard?'—requirements vary by contract and state. (Source: Medical Courier transcript)
- 4 For CCNA, hands-on labs (like those at NetworkChuck Academy) are a major shortcut to passing the exam and getting hired—employers value real lab experience over just book knowledge. (Source: Certification Questions transcript)
- 5 If you're starting as a courier, begin with a sedan to avoid expensive commercial insurance until you're ready to scale up. (Source: Courier Expenses transcript)

- 6 Always set up a separate business checking account for payment if you're working as a contractor—Bank of America, Wells Fargo, and local credit unions are commonly used. (Source: NEMT transcript)

Interview Talking Points

- 1 Highlight any hands-on experience (e.g. labs for CCNA, previous driving or delivery roles for courier/NEMT).

- 2 Emphasize reliability and compliance—mention your clean driving record, punctuality, and attention to regulations.

3 If you've already completed any required certifications (CCNA, HIPAA, NEMT), mention them and be ready to show proof.

4 Ask what ongoing training or certifications the employer provides or requires.

▶ **MODULE 16**

Red Flags / Scams To Avoid

Warning

Avoid any job or contract that asks you to pay for expensive certifications or insurance before you've spoken directly with the hiring manager or confirmed requirements in writing. Some third-party 'certification mills' sell unnecessary courses—always verify with the actual employer first. Never pay for a job listing or 'guaranteed placement'.

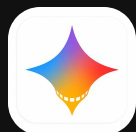
