Problem This Business Solves

Step-by-Step Launch Plan

- 1 Pick a path: Choose one (reselling, AI digital, micro SaaS, KDP, service) based on your interest and resources.
- 2 Research demand: Use BookBolt.io (for KDP), eBay sold listings (for reselling), or Google search (for services) to find real demand.
- 3 Set up your tool: For AI products, use Lovable.dev or Claude; for reselling, set up eBay/Facebook Marketplace; for KDP, sign up for BookBolt.io.
- 4 Create your first offer: Use a proven template (e.g. 'instant quote generator for [niche]' or 'spooky cute coloring book').
- 5 Validate with a small test: List one product or pitch one service to a real customer.
- 6 Iterate based on feedback: Adjust your offer, pricing, or delivery based on what people actually buy or ask for.

First 7 Days

- 1 List 5–10 items from your home on eBay or Facebook Marketplace (start with electronics, VCRs, cameras, etc.).
- 2 If digital: Build and publish your first Claude skill or KDP book using BookBolt.io's keyword tool to find a low-competition niche.
- 3 For service: Use the copy/paste outreach script below to contact 10 local businesses.
- 4 Track every response and sale in a simple spreadsheet (Claude can generate this for you).
- 5 Join 2–3 Facebook or LinkedIn groups in your target niche and answer questions to build credibility.

First 30 Days

- 1 Aim for 5–20 sales or client conversations (depending on path).
- 2 Test at least two pricing models (one-time vs. subscription for digital/services).
- 3 Collect and screenshot every testimonial or result (blur private info if needed).
- 4 Publish 2–3 pieces of hyper-specific content (e.g. 'Best Facebook Ads for Dental Implants') to attract inbound leads.
- 5 Upsell your first customers with a related offer (see Upsell Ideas below).

Insider Secrets & Shortcuts

- 1 Use BookBolt.io's keyword tool to find low-competition, high-demand book niches before creating anything—don't guess (AI Lets You Start This Amazon Side Hustle in Minutes).
- 2 For AI micro SaaS, prompt ChatGPT to write your Lovable.dev prompt for you—this gets better results than writing it yourself (The Simplest AI Side Hustle for Beginners).
- 3 When pitching services, use the exact line: 'Would you like some help with that?'—this non-pushy close converts at a high rate (How to Start an AI Marketing Agency).
- 4 Resell overlooked electronics: VCRs, camcorders, digital cameras, and Dell docking stations often sell for \$60–\$300+ on eBay, even when thrift stores price them at \$1 (The Best Side Hustle for Beginners).
- 5 For Claude skills, get granular—build one skill per subtask (e.g. 'SEO blog post writer') and sell as a package or use for consulting (The Beginner-Friendly Claude AI Side Hustle).
- 6 If you're doing local services (like grill cleaning), batch jobs by picking up all grates in one route, clean at a shop, then return—this can double your daily capacity (7 Low-Cost Business Ideas for Beginners).

How To Find Your First Customers

- 1 Tap your warm market: Post on Facebook/Instagram/LinkedIn using the script below.
- 2 For cold outreach: Search Google for businesses already running ads (e.g. 'dentist in Dallas'), then email or call with your offer.
- 3 Join niche Facebook/LinkedIn groups and answer real questions—don't spam.

- 4 For reselling: List on eBay, Facebook Marketplace, and check local Craigslist for wanted ads.
- 5 For digital products: List on Gumroad, Etsy, or Amazon KDP, using keyword research to optimize your listing.


