What The Job Actually Does

Appliance Repair Technicians diagnose, repair, and maintain household appliances like refrigerators, washers, dryers, dishwashers, and ovens. You'll work in homes, apartment complexes, or for retailers like Lowe's. Typical tasks include troubleshooting electrical/mechanical faults, replacing parts, and documenting repairs. Some roles also involve delivery and installation.

- 7 Day 7: Follow up on applications and reach out to local repair shops for shadowing opportunities.

▶ MODULE 11

30-Day Action Plan

- 1 Apply to at least 15 jobs (mix of apartment complexes, retailers, and property managers).
- 2 Complete EPA 608 certification (if needed).
- 3 Shadow or assist a tech for at least one full day.
- 4 Join local Facebook groups or forums for appliance repair jobs (search: 'appliance repair jobs [your city]').
- 5 Keep a log of every appliance you repair or assist with.
- 6 Ask every customer or manager for a reference or testimonial.
- 7 Update your resume with new experience and certifications.

Insider Secrets & Shortcuts

- 1 Get a heavy-duty appliance dolly with big tires (source: transcript—Amazon, check reviews for models that fit mattresses and box springs). This saves your back and time on every job.

- 2 Always keep gloves and a basic tool kit in your vehicle. The creator mentions using a power drill and sliding appliances down ramps to speed up deliveries.

- 3 For apartment complex jobs, property managers are often short-staffed and desperate for reliable techs—show up on time and be patient ('never get out of character' even when things go wrong).

- 4 Network with real estate agents and property managers—one creator added four to his client list just by handing out cards after jobs. These contacts lead to steady work and referrals.

- 5 If you're in Florida or the South, demand is especially high due to retirements and turnover (source: transcript).

- 6 Save a small emergency fund for vehicle repairs—unexpected costs like a blown tire can wipe out a week's pay if you're not prepared (Elite Auto and Tire in Sarasota helped a tech for free, but expect \$50–\$60 for a tire swap).

Interview Talking Points

- 1 Describe a time you diagnosed and fixed an appliance (even if it was your own).
- 2 Explain your approach to customer communication—mention getting signatures and documenting work.

- 3 Highlight your punctuality and patience (reference: 'never get out of character').
- 4 Mention your tool kit and readiness to work independently.
- 5 If EPA 608 certified, explain how you handle refrigerant safely.

► **MODULE 16**

Red Flags / Scams To Avoid

Watch for these red flags:

Avoid any 'appliance repair jobs' that require you to pay for leads, buy expensive starter kits, or operate as a 1099 contractor with no guaranteed work. Real jobs are W-2 with hourly or salary pay. Be wary of companies that won't provide a written job offer or require you to buy your own branded vehicle. If a company has a high number of negative reviews (search their name + 'scam' or 'complaints'), move on.
